

Taipei Xinsheng Elementary School Chinese Language Program(CLP)

How to apply?

1. Obtain your Alien Residence Certificate (ARC). Currently, first you have to get an Residence Permit, then you have to make residence registration in any district in Taipei City. After that, you can apply for a student identity for your child. Check for formal information and details for residence application from our government websites; you may browse or write to the following departments for details—*Taipei City DaAn District Office* <http://www.daan.taipei.gov.tw/> or *National Immigration Agency* http://www.immigration.gov.tw/immig_eng/aspcode/main4.asp.
2. Acquire a student identity in Taipei city. In order to get into our Chinese Language Program(CLP), your child has to be a Taipei City student. Our school is a fully registered school in the Daan District, this means that she/he has to register in another school in the Daan District or any other Taipei City school which has a vacancy for your child.
3. *Check for vacancy in our CLP class by calling/emailing to our office. If there is vacancy, then request your child's registered school to transfer your child the CLP Transference Application Form to our school.*
4. *Interview to CLP.*
5. *Take the CLP Chinese Test for checking Chinese level, learning attitude and ability.*

Who can apply to CLP?

1. Children of overseas civil servants of the Republic of China.
 2. Children of residents of the Republic of China.
 3. Overseas Chinese or Foreign elementary students who need help for their Chinese education.
- ✕ The above applicants must forward the application within 6 months of his/her arrival to Taiwan.

How long can CLP students stay?

All CLP students in our school receive a 2-year term Chinese education. After the 2-year Chinese program, he/she will be transferred back to the school of origin.

How do CPL students learn in Xinsheng?

Most of the time the CLP students learn with other ordinary students in the home class; with exceptions that sometimes they will be taken out from their home class for extra Chinese learning. Usually there will be 5 CLP Chinese classes per week; the periods of CLP classes for each student varies upon his/her Chinese level.

What documents are needed?

1. CLP Transference Application Form from any Taipei City Elementary School (official form can be got from Xinsheng website)
2. Passport and copy
3. Alien Residence Certificate (ARC) and copy
4. Previous School reports and copy
5. Vaccination records and copy
