Benefits

Students will:

- ✓ Connect with students across Queensland and the Asia-Pacific region.
- ✓ Hear from fellow young leaders in Australia and Asia and the Pacific.
- ✓ Develop their own strengths-based understanding of leadership, unique to their own skills and values to assist them become future school-based leaders.
- ✓ Explore a school-based challenge, generate ideas for addressing the challenge and present their project to their peers in the final session.

Teachers will:

- ✓ Participate in a learning briefing to explore curriculum links, content and gain an understanding of the project as a whole, prior to commencing the first online session.
- ✓ Provide an opportunity for students to develop intercultural understanding, critical and creative thinking skills, personal and social capabilities and all through the lens of global competence and leadership

Assessment

- ✓ Students complete a pre- and post-summit survey to measure growth in understanding, confidence and general capabilities.
- ✓ Optional rubric for teachers to assess students' collaboration and understanding throughout the workshops and final showcase presentation.

Learning Outcomes

Students will:

- ✓ Improve personal leadership skills such as critical and creative thinking, collaboration, and empathy.
- ✓ Encourage effective communication skills through active participation, intercultural understanding, seeking diverse perspectives, and presenting ideas.
- ✓ Strengthen global citizenship and international relationships.
- ✓ Utilise design thinking tools to understand and develop solutions to school-based challenges.

未來學校領袖計畫

澳洲昆士蘭教育廳 (Queensland Government Department of Education) 與亞洲教育基金會 (Asia Education Foundation) 合作辦理「未來學校領袖計畫」(Future School Leaders Program)。該計畫針對亞太地區 5 年級和 6 年級 (或相當年級) 的學生提供探索「全球思考，本地行動」概念的線上課程，讓亞太地區的同齡學生建立聯繫，並發展跨文化技能和全球競爭力。該計畫的工作坊將邀請嘉賓講者，進行協作學習活動，並設分組討論環節，讓學生有機會與來自昆士蘭及亞太地區其他學校的同齡人會面並討論相關議題。

該計畫預期學習成果如下：

- 提升個人領導能力 (批判性和創造性思維、合作與同理心)。
- 促進有效的溝通技能 (積極參與、跨文化理解、尋求多樣化觀點和表達想法)。
- 加強全球公民意識和國際關係。
- 運用設計思維工具，理解並開發解決學校挑戰的方案。
